

### **Approved Clinician Refresher Course- Online**

This is an online refresher course, suitable for qualified professionals who already have Approved Clinician status under the Mental Health Act and are due for renewal in the next 12 months. This course automatically covers Section 12(2) approval, so there is no need for doctors to attend a separate course for Section 12 renewal.

The online course consists of 4.5 hours of self-directed e-learning which will be shared with the candidates a week in advance followed by 3.5 hours of live webinars on 25.02.2025. The live webinar sessions are led by OxCME senior tutors. The course uses real and complex case studies, interactive quizzes, mini-lectures, small-group break-out sessions and legal updates to ensure delegates are fully equipped to continue working as Approved Clinicians.

Please note that this course is just part of the Approved Clinician renewal process. The course is recognised nationally but the process varies according to your location.
